In collaboration with and input from all relevant youth sports stakeholders, the Institute is designing and developing a set of comprehensive health and safety best practices, and will be awarding "Smart Team" status to Youth Sports Organizations (YSOs) which have demonstrated a commitment to minimizing the risk of physical and psychological injury to, and sexual abuse of, young athletes by implementing such practices.

Beginning September 2014 we will roll out six Smart Team youth football (ages 5-12) pilot programs with pilot coordinators from:

Michigan State - University of Tulsa - AT Still University - University of Tennessee - University of South Carolina - Texas A & M

NATIONAL Roll Out: all other Smart Teams programs for all organized team sports in 2015. Programs that achieve Smart Team™ status will provide safety-conscious sports parents a level of assurance that they have made health and safety an important priority, not to be sacrificed at the altar of team or individual success. The summit will serve to kick off the national Smart Teams program
